An AYSA initiative

AYSA has launched their Active Citizenship Programme which will run for the next year (Oct 2015 to July 2016). Children and youth are invited to register to enter the Programme as soon as possible.

Categories

Participants are asked to select from ONE of the following :

EDUCATION – participants are asked to develop an initiative that will improve the standards of education and academic achievement of learners. These may include forming study groups, advocacy for extra curriculum activities, etc.

SOCIAL OUTREACH – participants are to do voluntary work in the church and community, e.g. care for children or the elderly, doing odd jobs, etc.

ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION – participants are asked to start initiatives around saving of energy and water, nature conservation, etc.

ENTREPRENEURIAL Initiatives – participants are asked to develop an income generating project, e.g. vegetable/fruit gardens, clothing or jewellery manufacturing, etc.

The Categories are further broken down into the following age groups:

Age 6 to 12 years ; 13 to 18 years ; and, 19 to 35 years

Participants are asked to register on the web site www.ayacp.org.za (preferred method) or by emailing ayacp@aysa.org.za for a copy of the registration form. **Registration opens on 1st November 2015 & closes on 31st December 2015.**

The web site will provide regular updates on hints and tips and (virtual) mentorship will also be provided.
